



- 1. Insert the number of spacers required between the anti-derailleur and the frame. Tighten the 3 screws in steps to 6Nm.
- 2. Unscrew the small M4 screw (a) by one turn only, then completely unscrew the M5 screw from the fork (b) to rotate the cover.
- 3. Mount the crankset following the manufacturer's instructions. Place the chain around the chainring.
